## Countable Nouns(Sustantivos contables)

. Cuando se puede contar con unidades. Ejemplo: a book, an apple, two oranges.

### Uncountable nouns( Sustantivo incontable)

.Cuando no se puede contar con unidades. Por ejemplo: Water es incontable porque no se puede decir one water, two waters. Se necesita otra expresion como "one bottle of water" (una botella de agua).
